When 3MTM ScotchcalTM Overlaminate Film 3647 is applied to 3MTM ScotchcalTM Film 3662-10 in accordance with 3M recommended procedures to make Scotchprint® Graphics for Pavements, a warranty founded on 3MTM MCSTM will be given by 3M. The performance is based upon foot traffic experience in the field. Graphics may be damaged by frequent vehicular traffic or heavy equipment such as snowplows and snow shovels; minor edge chipping is unavoidable. These types of damage are not covered by 3M's warranty. Performance depends upon the condition and preparation of *unsealed*, *exterior*, *pedestrian traffic surfaces* before application, the exposure conditions, and the maintenance of the graphics.

Limitations of End Uses

Specifically, we do not warrant this film for the following:

- Exposure to vehicle traffic (except light, slow moving traffic such as on parade routes), snowplows, snow shovels, heavy equipment traffic
- Graphics subjected to gasoline vapors or spills.
